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DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed by petitioner Ramandeep Singh under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus to search the detenue namely Beant Singh, who is wife of the petitioner from the premises of respondents No.4 and 5.

Notice of motion in the case was issued on 11.04.2018. During pendency of the present petition, the matter was also sent to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court but it could not be settled. Thereafter, the case was adjourned on request of learned counsel for the petitioner for today.

Detenue Beant Singh is present in the Court and submits that she is residing with her parents as per her free will and it is not a case of illegal detention. She is being harassed by the petitioner-husband and was given threat from time to time. She was never supported by him and she does not want to remain with him. She also submits that she is having a female child of two and a half months and not only she was harassed but efforts were also made to kill the child.

Keeping in view the statement made by the detenue, no ground is made out to interfere in the matter as it cannot said to be a case of illegal detention. The petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.
