Memo of appearance filed on behalf of respondent No.5 is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that now the relief claimed is restricted to the point of grant of employment on compassionate ground. However, learned counsel contended that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to move proper representation before the respondents-Corporation for appointment on compassionate ground and some directions be issued to the respondents for decision of the representation within a time frame.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to move a detailed representation for compassionate appointment within a period of one month from today and if such a representation filed before the respondents, the same shall be decided by the respondents within three months after receipt of the representation, by passing a detailed speaking order. If the petitioners still feel aggrieved by the order passed by the respondents-Corporation, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court again.
