This petition pertains to the recovery of interest on the advance deposit/security with effect from 10.06.2003, the date of commencement of the Electricity Act, 2003.

Counsel for the respondent submits that the decision rendered by this Court in the case of **M/s. Induction Furnace Association, Ludhiana vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. and others**, CWP No.16261 of 2011, decided on 17.05.2012, relied upon by the petitioner, has been reversed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.1799 of 2014 titled as “**Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and another vs. M/s Induction Furnace Association of North India and another**”, decided on 20.09.2016.
