Petitioner Rajbala has approached this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the respondents to release detainee Manisha, who is her daughter-in-law, as well as her grandsons namely Jaidev and Vansh as their whereabouts are not known.

Vide order dated 30.07.2018 passed by this Court, a direction was issued to respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, Sonapat to ensure the presence of alleged detainee Manisha along with her two children before this Court.

Alleged detainee Manisha along with her two children is present in the Court and she submits that she was not on good terms with her mother-in-law and has left the matrimonial home when she was harassed. She is happily residing at her parental home along with her children and is not in illegal detention of any person.

Keeping in view the statement made by Manisha, no ground is made out to proceed further as it cannot be said to be a case of illegal detention as Manisha is residing in her parental home as per her free will.

Accordingly, the present petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.

However, the police authorities are directed not to harass the petitioner in case any complaint or representation is made against her.
