The petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detainee, namely, Mohan Singh @ Monu, who has been illegally confined by respondent No.3.

As per report of the Warrant Officer, the detainee – Mohan Singh @ Monu was found to be involved in FIR No.387, dated 21.12.2017 under Sections 341, 372 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station, Sector-11, Chandigarh and he is in judicial lock up.

In view of the above, the present petition seeking issuance of a writ of Habeas Corpus is dismissed as rendered infructuous.
