ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral):

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to release the detainee, namely, Jasika Joshi daughter of respondents No. 4 and 5, namely, Vijay and Rani Joshi.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that on an earlier occasion, detainee, Jasika Joshi, alongwith petitioner has filed CRM-M-14696-2018 praying for protection of their life and liberty, which was disposed of vide order dated 06.04.2018, observing that the Court is not examining the validity of the marriage of the petitioners and a simple direction was issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, to look into the grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation.

In compliance of order dated 09.07.2018, detainee, Jasika Joshi, alongwith her father is present in the Court.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4 submits that the detenue has also filed a complaint under Sections 420/498-A/323/34 IPC before the Illaqa Magistrate at Faridkot against the petitioner and his father and mother in which she has recorded a statement giving all the details. Photocopy of the statement is taken on record.

Even on the Court inquiry, the detenue has shown her willingness to stay with her parents and not to accompany the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered as infructuous.
