Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to direct respondents No.2 to 4 to get the detenue Khuspreet Kaur (daughter daughter of petitioners) released from the illegal custody of respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdev Singh, states that the alleged detenue Khuspreet Kaur was produced before the Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate and she made a statement that she apprehended threat at the hand of her uncle, namely, Sanju Singh son of Joginder Singh. Accordingly, she was sent to Nari Niketan and, therefore, she is no more in the illegal custody of Jagdeep Singh.

Considering the fact that the alleged detenue has been sent to Nari Niketan by the learned Magistrate vide order dated 19.07.2018, present petition is rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
