Daya Chaudhary, J. (Oral)

In pursuance of order dated 30.07.2018, the alleged detenue, namely, Anita, is present in the Court and submits that her husband has expired and under the pressure of the present petitioner, she got married with him. Subsequently, she came to know that the petitioner is drunkard and is not a good person. She has left the house of the petitioner and is residing with the parents of her earlier husband as per her free will. She also submits that she does not want to join the company of the petitioner.

ASI Khem Chand, is present in the Court and has filed reply in the Court and the same is taken on record.

Neither the petitioner nor his counsel is present. The petitioner has given an undertaking on the last date of hearing that he was ready to bear the expenses i.e., ₹20,000/- for calling the detenue in the Court but no such amount has been paid to detenue.

By considering the statement made by the alleged detenue- Anita, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is dismissed.

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However, the petitioner is directed to pay an amount of ₹20,000/- to the alleged detenue-Anita.

Respondent No.4-Station House Officer is directed to recover the amount from the petitioner and be paid to the alleged detenue-Anita.
