Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India and under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus and for appointment of a Warrant Officer with a roving writ to search for the detenues, at the premises of respondents No.3 and 4 or any any other place to be pointed out by the petitioner/relative at the spot and get the detenues released from the illegal police custody of official respondents forthwith.

Vide order dated 17.07.2018 while issuing notice of motion, a Warrant Officer was appointed in the case and was directed to submit a report.

Accordingly, the Warrant Officer has submitted his report dated 18.07.2018 wherein it has been reported that no such alleged detainee was found in the police custody.

In view of above report of Warrant Officer, this Court does not find any reason to interfere in the case.
