On 30.07.2018, the petition was filed by Balak Singh seeking intervention of this Court for release of the detenu, namely, Bikramjeet Singh who was allegedly in illegal detention w.e.f. 25.07.2018.

On the same day, the Warrant Officer was appointed and the direction was issued that in case he was found in illegal detention, he be got released. Pursuant to this order a status report dated 08.08.2018 is filed by Warrant Officer which is as under:-

“I received copy of the order on the same day at about 5.30 p.m. from the petitioner and we immediately left Chandigarh for Amritsar. We reached at Police Station Lopoke, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar at 10.40 p.m. where Incharge of the Police Station namely Kapil Kaushil was found present to whom I disclosed my identity and apprised him about the purpose of my visit. Then I checked lock up and adjoining room of the police Station where alleged detenu was not found either

detained or otherwise. On my query to Incharge of the Police Station regarding whereabouts of alleged detenu namely Bikramjeet Singh, he stated that alleged detenu had been arrested in connection with FIR No.151 dated 29.07.2018 under Sections 21, 61, 84 of the NDPS Act and heroin weighing 1.40 kg was recovered from the farm house of alleged detenue located on the Wagah Border. He further stated that alleged detenu was produced before the Ilaqua Magistrate, Ajnala, District Amritsar and at present alleged detenu is on police remand for two days which will last on 01.08.2018. He further stated that at present alleged detenu is in the custody of Joint Investigation Centre, Amritsar. He also supplied me copy of the FIR which is annexed as Annexure A.

In view of the above, I left back for Chandigarh after recording entry in the Roznamcha as DDR No.26 dated 30.07.2018 at 10.40 p.m.

The report is accordingly submitted for kind perusal.”

In view of the report, detention of son of the petitioner is justified and nothing survives for adjudication in this petition and the same is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
