The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for producing the detinue, namely Parmeet Kaur wife of Sanjeet Singh, petitioner herein.

In compliance with the order dated 31.07.2018, detinue Parmeet Kaur has been produced by ASI Balkar Singh and Lady Constable Suman Kaur.

The matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for finding some amicable settlement between the parties. The Mediator has recorded the statement of detinue Parmeet Kaur, who has stated that her date of birth is 02.07.1999 and she has solemnized marriage with petitioner Sanjeet Singh on 02.05.2018 and she wants to live with her husband as she is his legally wedded wife. Statement of respondent No. 5

Jasbir Singh, father of detainee Parmeet Kaur, has also been recorded wherein he has stated that he has no objection if his daughter wants to stay with petitioner Sanjeet Singh. In the statement of petitioner Sanjeet Singh, it is stated that he wants to take his wife Parmeet Kaur to his place of residence from the Court premises itself and he will be responsible for maintaining her.

During the course of arguments, respondent No. 5 Jasbir Singh, father of Parmeet Kaur, has shown apprehension that on the applications, being given by the petitioner, the police is harassing him, however, it seems to be on account of staying of the detainee with her parents that the petitioner has moved such applications to the police authorities.

Since the detainee is aged about 19 years and she is willing to stay with the petitioner with whom she has solemnized marriage, she is at liberty to stay with him.

This petition is disposed of, accordingly.

However, it is clarified that in case any complaint is made to the police authorities against respondent No. 5 Jasbir Singh, the police authorities will call him only after issuing notice in writing.
