Prayer in this criminal writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the official respondents to produce the detainee namely Rajni, daughter of the petitioner – Naveen Kumar, who has been allegedly kidnapped and detained by respondents No.4 to 6.

In pursuance to the notice of motion order, the detainee – Rajni is present in the Court and on the request made by counsel for the petitioner, in order to enable the petitioner to meet his daughter, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for recording the statement of the parties and exploring the possibility of some amicable settlement.

The Mediator, after recording the statement of the petitioner – Naveen Kumar, his wife namely Suman as well as their daughter – Rajni i.e. the alleged detainee and respondent No.4 namely Jaspreet Singh @ Dabbu has submitted a report that Rajni and Jaspreet Singh @ Dabbu i.e. respondent No.4, have performed marriage and the

petitioner and his wife have accepted their marriage and Rajni is now residing with her husband as a legally wedded wife. The parties have also settled their dispute with regard to FIR No.95 dated 31.07.2018 registered under Section 346 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Yamuna Nagar and they have further stated that they will remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement arrived at between them before the Mediator.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of.

The parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the award of the Mediator dated 18.09.2018.

The detenue is free to go with her husband namely Jaspreet Singh @ Dabbu.
