Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for the recovery of detenue Balwinder Kaur, stated to be wife of petitioner Simarjeet Singh.

Detenue Balwinder Kaur is present in the Court and she was sent to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court along with petitioner Simarjeet Singh for their counselling and recording their statement.

As per report of the Mediator, the following settlement has been arrived at between the parties: -

“(a) That Balwinder Kaur-detenue, who is major in age, has denied the factum of marriage between her and the

petitioner/first party. She has further denied having sent any SMS to the petitioner/first party. The parties have agreed that Balwinder Kaur-detenuue will continue to live with her parents for all the time to come to which the first party has no objection.

(b) That both the parties have agreed that the instant petition may be disposed of in terms of this settlement/compromise.

(c) Both the parties have agreed that they and their family members will obey/carry out the present settlement/agreement in all fairness.”

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous. However, it will be open for detenuue Balwinder Kaur to stay with her parents in terms of the settlement/compromise arrived at between the parties.
