ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to release the alleged detainee namely Agwal Singh.

As per the report of the Warrant Officer, dated 01.09.2018, the detainee Agwal Singh was found sitting on the boundary wall of the police station and no case was found registered against him.

Similar is the affidavit filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sri Muktsar Sahib, that the alleged detainee is not involved in any other case and during the investigation of one FIR No.140 dated 29.08.2018, under Sections 328/120-B IPC, Police Station Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib, registered against Gurpreet Singh @ Gauri son of Tegh Singh, real brother of the petitioner the police had conducted a raid at the house of the petitioner for arresting the aforesaid person and on that account, the present petition has been filed. Even a fresh affidavit of

Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sri Muktsar Sahib, dated

30.10.2018 has been filed today in the Court regarding the status of the case. As per the said affidavit, the aforesaid Gurpreet Singh @ Gauri son of Tegh Singh, brother of the petitioner has been arrested by the police on 04.09.2018 and co-accused Ravneet Kaur was also arrested on the same date and both the accused are in judicial custody since then.

In view of the same, no further action is required in this petition.

The petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
