ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing the detenue as mentioned in para No.3 of the petition, at the premises of the brick kiln of respondents No.5 and 6.

In pursuance to the notice of motion, two separate replies by way of affidavits of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Barwala, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 dated 10.10.2018 and Deputy Commissioner, Hisar dtd 22.10.2018 have been filed.

As per the reply filed by Deputy Commissioner, Hisar, a team was constituted to inspect the brick kiln and report the matter. A team comprising of Naib Tehsildar, Barwala, SHO Barwala, Assistant Food & Supply Controller Barwala and Labour Inspector, Hisar, inspected the aforesaid brick kiln on 04.10.2018 and it was found that the brick kiln is not functioning and no person was residing or found in the brick kiln and no bonded labour was found at the spot. The owner of the brick kiln informed that all the persons including the petitioner had already left the site on

25.09.2018.

On similar lines is the affidavit filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Barwala. In both the affidavits the report dated 04/05.10.2018, submitted by the Joint Inquiry Team is attached.

In view of the same, no further action is required in this petition.

The petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
