The matter pertains to the resumption of plot bearing No. 86 situated in New Mandi Township, Patran.

Shorn of unnecessary details, Rajinder Singh, Superintendent Grade-I, New Mandi Township, Punjab has filed an affidavit on 9.1.2018 in which he has averred that only an amount of Rs.6542/- is still outstanding against the purchaser. It is further averred that if the petitioner pays the said amount along with interest and penalty then the resumption order dated 18.12.1970 can be withdrawn and the plot in question can be restored.

Rajinder Singh, Superintendent Grade-I, is present in Court and has submitted through Mr. Sitta that penalty of Rs.200/- is also to be paid. It is submitted that if the petitioner pays Rs.6742/- within 30 days then the resumption order dated 18.12.1970 would be withdrawn.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner shall deposit the requisite amount within time.

Thus, in view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.
