Learned State counsel has filed reply of Daljeet Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, Hisar on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on the basis of reply submits that statement of detenue was recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. before Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hissar wherein it has been stated that she has left the house as per her own free will and now she is residing with her sister Monika who is married in Hanumangarh. It has also been stated that there is no fault of the boy Subham.

Keeping in view the statement recorded of the alleged detenue, it can not be said to be a case of illegal detention as detenue is major. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
