This petition was brought by Rekha on the apprehension that her husband namely Ravinder Yadav @ Kale is detained in illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6 and she expressed apprehension that there may be a fake encounter to eliminate him.

Status report has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6 by way of affidavit of Dharamvir Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Manesar, Gurugram.

It is an admitted fact that Ravinder Yadav, who stood convicted in a criminal case and was sentenced for seven years rigorous imprisonment in the year 2016 by the learned Additional Session Judge, Gurugram and was serving his sentence. The concession of parole was extended for a period of 28 days to enable him to get medical treatment of her elder daughter and was released on 08.08.2018. He was scheduled to surrender on 05.09.2018.

During this period, one Ishwar Singh, Patwari associated with HSIIDC was murdered and the case FIR No.206 dated 14.08.2018 was registered under Sections 332/353/333/186/302/120-B/447/506/307/109 IPC and 25/54/59 Arms Act at Police Station Manesar, Gurugram. The husband of petitioner is found to be involved in the case as disclosed by other accused persons.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sh. Manabir Singh, DSP, State Crime Branch Faribabad informs that another case FIR No.250 dated 18.09.2018 for the offences under Sections 186, 332, 353 and 307 read with Section 34 IPC was registered at Police Station Manesar, Gurugram and the husband of petitioner was arrested on 23.10.2018. Presently, he is confined in judicial custody.

In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner states that nothing survives for adjudication in the present petition and the same has become infructuous.

Disposed off as such.
