Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the respondents to produce the detenues Jatinder Kaur (daughter of petitioner No.1-Ajaib Singh) and Harmandeep Singh (son of petitioner No.2).

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Talwinder Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, in court today on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which is taken on record. Reply is accompanied with the affidavits/self declaration of Harmandeep Singh as Annexure P-3 and Jatinder Kaur as Annexure P-4, wherein they have stated that since they were apprehending threat/danger to their lives from the family members of Jatinder Kaur, it necessitated them to seek protection/security from this

They are no more in need of any protection/security. Similarly, Ajaib Singh-petitioner No.1 has also made statement at Annexure R-5, which reads as under:-

“Stated that I am resident of above mentioned address and I am doing the labour work. My daughter Jatinder Kaur got her court marriage with Harmandeep Singh son of Pippal Singh resident of Village Wattu, who were residing under police protection at Red Cross Bhawan SMS. I have removed all my grudge against my daughter Jatinder Kaur so I want to take my daughter in well and good condition with myself and I will not cause any harm to my daughter and will protect her completely. The statement has got reduced in writing before your goodself, which is heard and the same is admitted to be correct.”

In view of aforesaid facts, when Jatinder Kaur and Harmandeep Singh the alleged detenues have furnished their affidavits, present petition no more survives and is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
