In this criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for direction especially in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing Detenue namely Raveena Sanyal wife of Pawan Kumar from the unlawful detention/illegal custody of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Kaur submitted that Raveena Sanyal wife of petitioner – Pawan Kumar has approached the police and affidavit has been filed stating reasons for leaving her husband-petitioner. Having regard to these facts and circumstances read with the fact that Raveena Sanyal, wife of the petitioner is present in person, the present habeas corpus petition do not survive for consideration.
