Laljeet Singh had sent this complaint dated 26.09.2018 by post levelling allegations against ASI Kashmir Singh regarding harassment meted out to him. It is alleged that the complainant and ASI Kashmir Singh are neighbours and many a time the dispute erupted between them. Through this application sent by post, which was treated as writ petition, it was prayed that legal action may be taken against ASI Kashmir Singh and protection be provided to the life and property of the petitioner-Laljeet Singh.

Learned State counsel has filed the affidavit of Laljeet Singh (petitioner) son of Mukhtar Singh indicating the matter between the parties is compromised and he does not wish to proceed with this petition.

Petitioner-Laljeet Singh is also present in Court and reiterates this fact that he is not willing to pursue this matter as the parties have entered into a compromise.
