The Warrant Officer has submitted his report dated 25.10.2018, according to which, the alleged detainee could not be found either in the house of the respondent No.4 or in the house of his brother. The house of sister of respondent No.4 was also searched, but she was not found present there either.

Short reply dated 31.10.2018 has been filed in Court on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. The same is taken on record. According to this reply, the police has also not been able to trace the alleged detainee.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 states that the daughter of the petitioner (alleged detainee) had got married with respondent No.4.

The alleged detainee is present in Court. She states that she has married respondent No.4 and is now residing with him at Ludhiana in the house of one of his friends.

The petitioner is also present in Court. He states that he wants to meet his daughter for some time.

The parties have met in my chamber and the petitioner is satisfied.

Thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
