This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to release the detenues, whose names are mentioned in para No.3 of the petition, who are stated to be in the illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a detailed representation was moved to the Deputy Commissioner, Panchkula (Haryana) on 14.10.2018 but still no action has been taken thereupon. He also submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to respondent No.2 for taking action on the pending representation.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take action on the pending representation in accordance with law. However, in case, the persons as mentioned in para No.3 of the

petition are found to be in the illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5, they be released forthwith by passing a detailed speaking order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
