Present petition was filed on the ground that three persons namely, Jorawar Singh, jobanjit Singh and Davinder Singh were in illegal custody of the police.

Learned State counsel filed reply by way of affidavit of Jaspreet Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Amritsar and contended that all these three persons were accused in case FIR No.173 dated 07.10.2018, under Sections 21, 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar City, FIR No.175 dated 08.10.2018, under Sections 21, 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar City, and DDR No.06 dated 12.10.2014, under Section 190 and 151 Cr.P.C, registered at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar City respectively. Accused Jorawar Singh was arrested on 07.10.2018, Jobanjit Singh was arrested on 08.10.2018 and Davinder Singh was arrested on 12.10.2018 in the above said cases, and as such, the present petition would not be maintainable.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
