The present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for effecting the release of the detainee namely, Harpreet Sharma, aged 20 years wife of the present petitioner from the illegal confinement of respondent Nos.4 to 9, with further direction to official respondents to produce the detainee before this court from the illegal confinement of respondents No.4 to 9.

Detenue-Harpreet Sharma is present in the court. She has submitted that she wants to stay with her parents and she is residing with them happily. She has categorically stated that she is not willing to reside with the petitioner.

Detenue is residing with her parents, the custody which cannot be taken as unauthorized or illegal.

In this view of the matter, the present petition stands dismissed with cost of Rs.25,000/- which shall be paid by the petitioner to detainee Harpreet Sharma, within one month.
