Challenge in the present civil writ petition is to letters dated 09.04.2017 and 24.04.2017 (Annexure P-6 and P-9) issued by respondent No.3 vide which the petitioners have been directed to deposit an amount of Rs.1,07,650/-.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 & 3 states that the said amount deposited by the petitioners stands adjusted towards the costs of B-class gunny bags and at this stage, nothing remains to be settled. Thereafter, the impugned letters (Annexure P-6 & P-9) stand withdrawn along with the complaint filed by respondent No.3 under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.

In this view of the matter, nothing survives in the present petition and therefore, the same has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, in case any grievance of the petitioners still subsists, they are free to approach the Arbitrator as provided in the agreement clause.
