On the basis of a representation submitted by Major Singh Gill (petitioner herein), the present criminal writ petition was numbered.

As per the representation dated 19.10.2018 submitted by the petitioner, on 17.10.2018 at about 11.00 PM, the police officials of Police Station City Tarn Taran took away his son Himmatveer Singh @ Sonu from his house without any reason and he has been kept in illegal custody. The petitioner apprehends that the police officials might implicate his son in some false case.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Sucha Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, in court today, which is taken on record. He, on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh, states that the petitioner has made a statement on 10.11.2018 to the effect that his son Himmatveer Singh @ Sonu had left the house for Harmandir Sahib (Amritsar) in order to

perform *sewa* without informing the family and in this manner, the complaint was made under some wrong impression. However, Himmatveer Singh @ Sonu is now residing in his home with his family. He was neither picked up by any police official nor he is implicated in any case.

In view of the statement so made by the petitioner, present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.
