Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus to release the detenues Rajbir Singh @ Judge and Davinder Singh from the illegal custody of respondent No.3.

Pursuant to the order dated 06.11.2018 passed by this Court, learned State Counsel has filed the affidavit of Inspector Paramjit Singh, SHO, P.S. Ajnala, Amritsar Rural, which is taken on record. It has been stated in the affidavit that neither any FIR has been registered on 04.11.2018 or till date thereafter against the alleged detenues Rajbir Singh @ Judge and Davinder Singh, nor they were detained on 04.11.2018 or thereafter at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural. He further states that the detenues are not wanted by the Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural as on date.

In view of the categoric statement so made in the affidavit, this Court finds that the present petition does not require any further consideration.

Disposed of accordingly.
