On 17.11.2018, the following order was passed:-

“Ruby Rani wife of Rakesh Kumar, resident of House No.982, Gali Darshan Tent House, Ghanupur Kale, Chheharta, Amritsar, had sent this complaint by post, which pertains to taking away of her husband, namely, Rakesh Kumar s/o Jagdish Chand, resident of House No.982, Gali Darshan Tent House, Ghanupur Kale, Chheharta, Amritsar, by the police officials of CIA Staff from Police Station Tarn Taran. She was informed that her husband is being taken for interrogation and will be released soon. It is pleaded that she does not know whereabouts of her husband.

As per this complaint, she prays for taking action against the police officials and release of her husband from the custody of police officials of CIA Staff, Tarn Taran. The complaint has been treated as Criminal Writ Petition No.904 of 2018 and is put up on judicial side.

Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, AAG, Punjab is directed to

ascertain and verify the details of the husband of the petitioner and submit the status report to this Court on 20.11.2018.”

Today, learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of an affidavit of Satnam Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, District Tarn Taran which reveals that husband of the petitioner has returned back home and she is not willing to pursue this complaint.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
