Pursuant to order dated 12.11.2018, the alleged detainee namely Megha has been produced in the Court today.

Learned counsel representing respondents No. 4 to 7 submits that aforementioned Megha wants to reside with her parents and does not want to keep any relationship with the petitioner. She was being misguided by the petitioner but now she has realized her mistake. Thus, the petition may be dismissed.

I have spoken to the alleged detainee in my Chamber. She has conveyed that the allegations made in the petition are correct. She wants to reside with the petitioner as she is his legally wedded wife.

It is, thus, directed that aforementioned Megha will accompany the petitioner from this Court itself. Respondent No. 2 is directed to ensure that no harm is caused either to the petitioner or to the detainee. The Investigating Officer is directed to accompany the couple to their home in Palwal.

The petition is disposed of.
