Mr. S.K.Verma, Advocate and Mr. Nishant Arya, Advocate have appeared on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 and filed power of attorneys respectively. The same are taken on record.

Even on second call none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

This petition has been filed by petitioner-Salim seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus so as to seek release of 12 detenues alleged to be forcibly detained at the Brick Kiln of respondent No.4.

Vide order dated 30.11.2018, this Court had directed for appointment of a Warrant Officer so as to visit the premises of respondents

No.4 and 5 and in case the detenues are found detained illegally to get them released.

Report of Warrant Officer has been received to the effect that although the Clerk to the counsel had met him and stated that the petitioner would meet him at his residence in morning on 2.12.2018 but nobody turned up and as such the raid could not be conducted.

I find that the petitioner does not seem to be interested in pursuing this petition as he has neither taken any step for depositing the requisite fee of the Warrant Officer nor has contacted him thereafter. So much so the counsel for the petitioner has not turned up today despite the matter having been called twice. As such, the petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
