An e-mail was received from petitioner-Darshana Devi wife of Mukesh Kumar, resident of H.No.5574, Street No.22, Gobind Nagar, Shimla Puri, Near Harkrishan School, Ludhiana, stating therein that her son Saggar aged about 25 years has been arrested by SHO-Sehzad, Police Station No.1, Chaura Bazar, Ludhiana on 26.11.2018 and he is demanding ₹50,000/- from her. Thus, she has apprehended false implication of Saagar in the case.

On the basis of said communication, same was registered as CRWP-985-2018 and notice of motion was issued in the case.

Learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Waryam Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (Central), Ludhiana. On the basis of aforesaid affidavit, he states that on 29.11.2018, when the police-party headed by ASI Hardev Singh was present at Rikhi Chowk,

Ludhiana in connection with patrolling duty, a secret information was received that Saagar and his accomplices are having an Auto, bearing registration No.PB-10GK-7724 and when the passengers sits in their Auto, they used to steal mobile phones from the pockets of the passengers. On the aforesaid allegations, FIR No.236 dated 29.11.2018 under Sections 379, 411 IPC, Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana, was registered against Saagar and his co-accused. They were apprehended and two stolen mobile phones were recovered from Saagar, which were stolen from the passengers of the Auto. Three other mobile phones were recovered from the co-accused.

In view of the fact that Saagar, son of the petitioner, is an accused in FIR No.236 dated 29.11.2018 under Sections 379, 411 IPC, Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana, prayer of the petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus is nothing, but an attempt to mount pressure on the police.

Dismissed.
