1. Petitioner has preferred the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking quashing of order dated 13.04.2018 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.3 accepting the tender submitted by respondent No.4 against the conditions envisaged under the Policy, Annexure P-1.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that during the pendency of the writ petition, respondent No.3 i.e. the District Food and Supplies Controller-cum-Convener Tender Allotment Committee, Sangrur has passed an order dated 04.05.2018 rejecting the claim of the petitioner.

3. Faced with such a situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has made a prayer for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to file a

fresh one on the same cause of action and to lay a challenge to order dated 04.05.2018.

4. Accordingly, the instant petition as well as CM-6537-CWP-2018 are dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
