By filing the present present, the petitioner seeks quashing the order dated 27.04.2015 (**Annexure P-5**) passed by the SDM-cum-Collector, Zira (Ferozepur), whereby his appeal, filed under Section 126 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against Notice No. 1969 dated 30.08.2011 (**Annexure P-1**), imposing fine of Rs. 1,26,815/- for theft of electricity, was dismissed.

Upon notice, no reply has been filed.

At the time of hearing, it is noticed that since last four consecutive dates, counsel for the petitioner has only once appeared and abstained from hearing on three occasions, the position also is same today.

In view of above, this Court finds that counsel for the petitioner is not willing to pursue the present petition, and, therefore, the same is liable to be dismissed for non-prosecution.
