Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to return the original medical certificate, which is lying with the respondent-department, while submitting documents for the release of handicapped allowance.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner stood retired on 30.04.2016 as Block Primary Education Officer on attaining the age of superannuation. Petitioner moved a legal notice dated 14.01.2018 (P-5) to the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid legal (P-5) in a time bound manner.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- The Director Public Instruction (EE), Punjab, Vidya Bhawan, Phase VIII, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 14.01.2018 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
