The instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as Hindi Master from the date his junior has been given promotion.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has been promoted to the post of Hindi Master. However, the promotion ought to have been made w.e.f. 11.02.2014 instead of 13.07.2018.

Considering the fact that the substantial relief has been allowed to the petitioner, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.

However, the petitioner is free to represent with regard to the

remaining prayer, which the respondents shall deal with as per law within three months from the date of receipt of any such application.
