Prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-Department for grant of minimum wages as fixed under the Minimum Wages Act as is already being granted to the similarly situated employees and to release the arrears along with 18% interest from the due date till the same actually paid.
