In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged the order of discontinue dated 17.04.1999 (Annexure P-5) as a Apprenticeship Training.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that on 17.4.1999, his Apprenticeship Training were discontinued. In respect of Hitesh Kumar and Bhupesh Kumar, they have approached this Court in the year 1999 and their case was decided in their favour on 28.03.2000. Thus, claim of the petitioner is squarely covered by the judgement of this Court passed in CWP Nos.11403 of 1999 and CWP No.11404 of 1999; decided on 28.3.2000.

Having regard to the conduct of the petitioner in respect of delay and laches in filing the present petition insofar as challenge to discontinue order dated 17.4.1999 as Apprenticeship Training to the extent that he slept over the matter for more than one and half decade-. On that score itself, petitioner is not entitled to any relief.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
