By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to re-fix his pension as per circulars dated 23.02.2014, 13.10.2014, 17.08.2009, 22.02.2009 and 15.12.2011 (Annexures P-1 to P-7) in view of increase in the pay scales and grade pay in terms of judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No. 25133 of 2012 titled as *A.P. Sharma and others vs. State of Punjab and others* as well as in view of policy decision of Punjab Government conveyed vide letter No. 4/13/2013-1FPPC/1010607/1, dated 27.07.2017 (P-18) and in CWP No. 2866 of 2014, titled as *Karanvir Singh and*

other vs. State of Punjab and others and also grant him all the consequential benefits accruing therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondent(s) to decide the legal notice dated 22/26.07.2017 (Annexure P-15) in view of the circulars dated 23.02.2014, 13.10.2014, 17.08.2009, 22.02.2009 and 15.12.2011 (Annexures P-1 to P-7) as well as judgments of this Court passed in CWP No. 25133 of 2012 titled as ***A.P. Sharma and others vs. State of Punjab and others*** and CWP No.2866 of 2014, titled as ***“Karanvir Singh and others v. State of Punjab and others***, decided on 30.09.2016 and also in view of policy decision of Punjab Government conveyed vide letter No. 4/13/2013-1FPPC/1010607/1, dated 27.07.2017 (P-18), within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 22/26.07.2017 (Annexure P-15) and to decide the same particularly in view of circulars dated in view of the circulars dated 23.02.2014, 13.10.2014, 17.08.2009, 22.02.2009 and 15.12.2011 (Annexures P-1 to P-7) as well as judgments of this Court passed in CWP No. 25133 of 2012 titled as ***A.P. Sharma and others vs. State of Punjab and others*** and CWP No.2866 of 2014, titled as ***“Karanvir Singh and others v. State of Punjab and others***, decided on 30.09.2016 and also in view of policy decision of Punjab Government conveyed vide letter No. 4/13/2013-1FPPC/1010607/1, dated 27.07.2017 (P-18), within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case the petitioner is still aggrieved by any of the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to him under law including to approach this Court.
