By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioners as Inspector from the post of Junior Assistant w.e.f. juniors were promoted as Inspector with all consequential benefits including arrears of pay etc.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide legal notices dated 27.01.2016/06.07.2017 (Annexures P-6 & P-7), within a stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Director,

Local Government Punjab, Municipal Bhawan, Sector 35-A, Chandigarh to

look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notices dated 27.01.2016/06.07.2017 (Annexures P-6 & P-7) and to take a conscious decision, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
