The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the pending application dated 20.09.2017 (Annexure P-6) filed under Sections 5 and 23 of the Maintenance and Welfare of the parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said application is pending for the last almost seven months but not even a single date has been given. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to decide the pending application within some stipulated period.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to make all efforts to decide the pending application dated 20.09.2017 (Annexure P-6) preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
