DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondents No.1 and 2 to issue passport to the petitioner, which has been withheld without any sufficient reason.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an objection was raised and conveyed vide letter dated 14.03.2017. In response to said letter, the petitioner made a representation to the respondent authorities stating therein that a cancellation report has been submitted by the police before the Court and the same has been accepted. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to take action on representation dated 15.03.2018 (Annexure P-8).

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider representation dated 15.03.2018 (Annexure P-8) moved by the petitioner and take necessary action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
