In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner is aggrieved by his transfer from GSSS, Mehrana (Jhajjar) to GSSS, Rampur Thadeon (Panchkula), caused pursuant to an order dated 13/17.4.2018 (Annexure P-4). Primarily, the grievance of the petitioner is; that his transfer is in breach of the Teachers Transfer Policy, 2016. Additionally, his wife is also employed at GSSS, Seria, (Jhajjar), and his children are also studying in a local college. Thus, it is urged that the respondents ought to have examined his case even from this perspective.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be re-examined, notwithstanding the impugned order of his transfer. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed within a period of one week from today. And, if the petitioner is not already relieved, he shall not be relieved from his original posting, till a decision, as indicated above, is reached.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim/grievance of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
