JASPAL SINGH, J

Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for grant of ante-dated promotion as Officiating Inspector of Police with all consequential benefits on notional basis as the similar relief/promotions as Inspector of Police has been granted to the numerous co-employees of the petitioner vide (P-7 (colly)) to P-10 respectively) and further to decide representations dated 15.01.2015 & 31.08.2016 (P-5 & P-6).

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner moved representations dated 15.01.2015 (P-5) and 31.08.2016 (P-6) but till date no action has been taken. Even some more development(s) have also taken place which are not included in the aforesaid representation(s)

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the

petitioner to file a detailed representation unfolding all the facts and grievances before the concerned authorities/respondents, which shall be dealt with and disposed of by respondents No. 2 to 4, within a period of three months from the date of filing of representation.

4. However, in case, petitioner feels aggrieved qua any order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
