JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The father of the petitioner, namely Parkash Singh, died in harness on 22.09.2017, while working as Ward Attendant at PHC, Mahel Kalan, District Sangrur.

The grievance of the petitioner is that his case for compassionate appointment on any Class-IV post is not being forwarded by the office of Civil Surgeon for consideration.

It is submitted that petitioner's brother, namely, Manjit Singh has furnished his affidavit dated 20.11.2017 (**Annexure P-7**), extending his no objection for appointment of the petitioner on compassionate appointee.

Mrs. Lavanya Paul, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, was directed to verify the facts.

At the time of resumed hearing today, learned State Counsel, on instructions from Dr. Shiplum Agnihotri, Medical Officer, submits that the brother (Manjit Singh) of the petitioner has subsequently made a representation, raising his claim for compassionate appointment, however

states that an appropriate order will be passed by the Civil Surgeon, Barnala, in respect of the rival claim made by the legal heirs of late Sh. Parkash Singh.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the State Counsel, nothing more requires to be adjudicated in the present petition, as the same has become infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.
