RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J (Oral) :

The petitioner is the association of private Industrial Training Institutes (in short 'the ITI's'). It is aggrieved against the establishment of centre for the NCVT Examination to be held shortly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently argued that in so far as the Government ITIs are concerned, their examination centres have been retained in the same premises, whereas in case of the private ITIs, examination Centres have been established at Polytechnic Colleges and Engineering Colleges. He has referred to Clause 4.40 and 4.41 of the Training Manual for Industrial Training Institutes, to contend that All India Trade Tests may be conducted only in affiliated ITIs having a minimum capacity of 8 Units of NCVT and should be at least 5 years old.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel did not deny that the Punjab State has received the Examination Schedule from the Government of India and uploaded it on its website the centres and program for the purpose of holding exam of the students of private institutes in the

Polytechnic Collages and Engineering Colleges. The petitioner has approached this Court at the fag end when the schedule of examination has already been released which is attached at page 41 B of the writ petition.

Since, there is hardly any time left with this Court to take any action in regard to the contention raised, therefore, the present petition is hereby dismissed on the ground that the relief sought by the petitioner has become redundant at this stage.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the future examination, the petitioner may make a representation to the respondents. May do so in accordance with law.
