Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to grant extension in service of two years in terms of judgment dated 25.05.2011 (Annexure P-4) and to grant all consequential benefits in lieu of extension in service of two years already granted to the petitioner in terms of notification and letter dated 08.10.2012 (Annexure P-2 colly.).

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that as per communication dated 08.10.2018 issued by the District Education Officer (Secondary Education), Faridkot, the petitioner has been given all the benefits of extension as are admissible to the employees of the handicapped category. A copy of the communication dated 08.10.2018 furnished by learned State counsel in the Court, is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

In view of the above, as the relief sought by the petitioner has

already been granted to him, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.
