The prayer in the present petition is for extension of period of parole as earlier the petitioner was granted parole for meeting his ailing father. Petitioner was granted parole for a period of ten days. During parole period, the father of the petitioner had expired on 21.04.2018. Thereafter, the present petition has been filed for extension of period of parole to perform certain rituals after death of his father.

In response to notice of motion, reply has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has affirmed the factum of death of father of the petitioner mentioning therein the details of the cases registered against him. He has been convicted in four cases whereas he has been acquitted in four cases. Earlier he was directed to surrender on 27.04.2018 and after filing of this petition, his period of parole was extended up to 01.05.2018. It has also been stated on the basis

of information sought from the SHO concerned that the last rites and rituals of the father of the petitioner are to be performed on 07.05.2018.

Keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the parties, the period of parole is extended up to 10.05.2018. Petitioner is directed to surrender before jail authorities on 11.05.2018.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
