JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

Prayer in the instant petition is for quashing of impugned resolutions dated 28.08.2008 (Annexure P-2A) and dated 30.06.2010 (Annexure P-4), thereby providing re-employment to the retired employees beyond the age of 58 years.

Heard.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondents state that petitioner Nos.3 and 4 have already been promoted during the pendency of the instant petition. Further, the promotions of the remaining petitioners shall be made in due course. It is also stated that no one junior to the petitioners has been promoted during the interregnum.

Keeping in view the fact that the main grievance of the petitioners that the posts which ought to have been filled up by promotions/direct recruitment, are being filled up by re-employing the retired employees, thereby, adversely hampering their promotional prospects, no longer subsists, accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that no employee, junior to the petitioners be promoted and no vacancy be filled up through re-employment prior to the promotion of the petitioners, if they are otherwise eligible and qualified for promotion.
