This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India questioning the creation of a new Gram Sabha.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that most of the residents are against it which is evident from the signed representation that they have submitted. Consequently, we are unable to appreciate the grievance of the petitioners in this regard.
